HOLIDAY BAZAAR

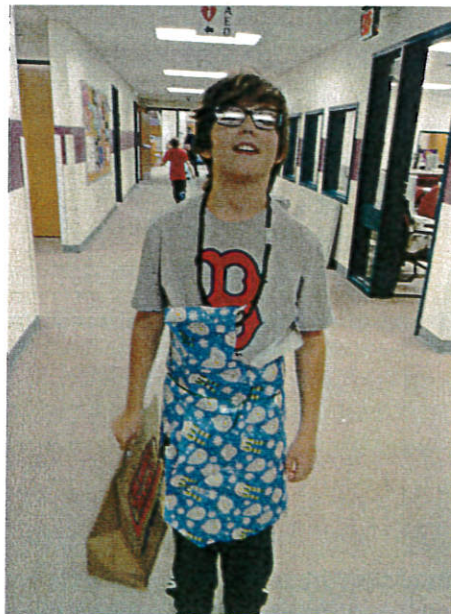
