Six Flags READ TO SUCCEED Starts this Week!

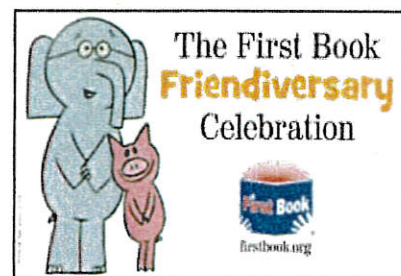

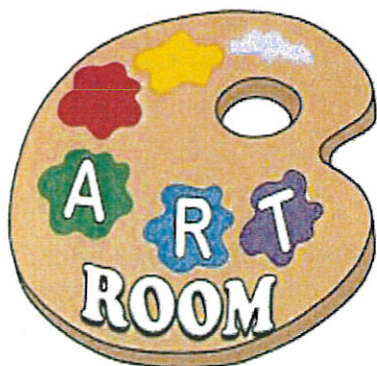

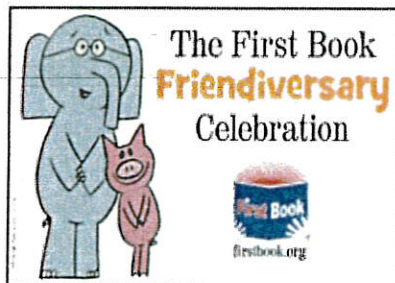
