



Six Flags READ TO SUCCEED returns to EES

BUT in a new format: it's all online!

use this code to register: **VY58J**

The other big change is that students have until Friday, April 17, 2020 to read their six hours and earn their *Six Flags* ticket.

Students in grades K-6 will receive the information about the *Six Flags Reading Club* which is an optional program that awards students a free ticket this coming summer to the Springfield, MA Six Flags Amusement Park. Ms. Urban will hand out a paper copy of the reading log, but all families will need to go to the Six Flags website: sixflags.com/books register using this code: **VY58J** and then keep track of their reading on the website.

To earn the ticket, students must read at least 6 additional hours [beyond homework requirements] and log the reading time on the website by Friday, April 17. Ms. Urban will monitor the registrations, to make sure that only current EES students in Kindergarten-6th grade are registered. Then in May she will pass out the tickets from Six Flags.

Students can:

- read books, magazines, graphic novels & e-books on their own,
- OR be read to by someone else,
- OR listen to an audio version or e-book format.
- The only thing that doesn't count is "watching the movie."
